Animals at Monroe County Shelter**

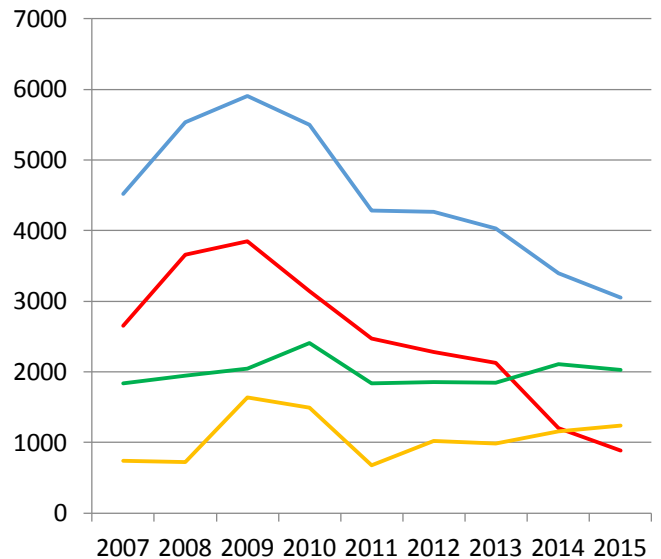
Where are we?

Total animals spayed and neutered each year through the Spay Neuter Assistance for Pets program (SNAP) is holding at the planned level (yellow). This program provides free vouchers to low income Monroe County residents to have their pets spayed or neutered.

Total saved animals (adoptions, rescues) is continues at about 2000 per year. (Green)

Due to the above programs, intake (blue) and euthanasia (red) continue to drop each year.

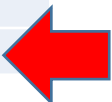
What do we need to do?



Blue – Shelter Intake
Red – Shelter Euthanasia
Green - Animals Saved
Yellow - Annual Free Vouchers

Continue funding and promoting SNAP at least at current levels, thereby continuing to reduce intake at the shelter.

Save 2000 animals a year (current level) or more through funding and operating current and new adoption/rescue programs.

Watch Euthanasia numbers drop until we reach our goal in 2018.
